The Keystone Chapter American College of Surgeons invites all KCACS member Residents and Medical Students to submit abstract papers and/or Case Study Reports for presentation at the 2024 Spring Educational Conference being held May 3, 2024 at WellSpan Park in York, PA.

Requirements for Submission:

- Submitting Resident or Medical Student must be an active member of KCACS. Not a member, visit: <u>https://www.kc-acs.org/join-us</u>. You must be an active member of ACS (<u>https://www.facs.org</u>) to join KCACS.
- Complete the submission form and submit with your abstract or case study in a PDF file.
- 250-word count maximum for submissions. Submissions above this will not be considered.
- Previously presented abstracts will be accepted, unless published with copyright licensure. Case Study Reports must be original.

Educational Outcomes:

- Evaluate the quality of the research presented and offer actionable comments.
- Apply new information learned from the presentation to their own practice, if applicable.
- Utilize the session to form collaborations between institutions in the same geographic regions with the same interests.

Top submission will present their research paper as a podium presentation during the educational meeting on Friday, May 3, 2024.

All abstracts/case studies selected will present using a poster presentation format on <u>May 3rd, from 8:00 AM</u> to 1:00 PM. Abstract/case study submitters must be present during this time to be eligible for prizes.
